The Central government has approved six proposals to set up centres of excellence to under the National Initiative for Development and Harnessing Innovation (NIDHI), Department of Science and Technology. "The proposals for six centres of excellence September 3 by the National Expert Advisory Committee include SINE-IIT Bombay, CIIE-IIM Ahmedabad and a research park at IIT-Gandhinagar," Harsh Vardhan, Mi Technology, told reporters here on Tuesday.
