National award for NCL technology business incubator

Pune: City-based technology business incubator Venture Center at the National Chemical Laboratory (NCL) has bagged the National Award for Technology Business Incubation for this year.

The incubator houses startups in technology space, which offer products and services in the areas of materials, chemicals and biological sciences and engineering. Today Venture Center is today home to 35 scientific ventures. NCL has shared that most of these are inventive enterprises driven by scientists and engineers. Women entrepreneurs have founded more than 30% of the startups incubated at Venture Center.

National Chemical Laboratory, Pune, which was established in 1950, is a constituent laboratory of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR).
