Introduction

Startup Launch Acceleration Program is designed specifically for early stage innovators and startups in deep tech domains. This is a sector agnostic acceleration program of 11 days durations, which focuses on key aspects of science and technology-based entrepreneurship. The program will include the following:

- Talks on different aspects of entrepreneurship like: Entrepreneurship Essentials; Value Proposition; Business Planning;
 Company Operations; Financial Planning; Intellectual Property; Raising Money; Pitching; Marketing and few essential Skills for entrepreneurs
- Mini workshops (total 5)
- Mentoring clinics (total 3), slots will be available on first-cum basis
- Diagnostic and Action Clinics
- Visit to deep-tech startup locations
- Group discussions
- Lunch side chats with deep-tech startup founders

SLAP is designed for young entrepreneurs who are initiating their entrepreneurial journeys. Some practical tips and pointers based on real-life experiences will be shared by the speakers, experts and mentors in this program. The idea is to enthuse and inspire young entrepreneurs and provide them a common launch pad to take off and accelerate their startup journeys.


